Ahman Green NFL All-Pro and former Husker star Ahman Green was roasted by Athletic Director Tom Osborne from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and two of his former teammates from the Green Bay Packers: fullback William Henderson and offensive guard Marco Rivera (by video). They were joined by Green's former Central High School teammate, Jono Bradford, and, also by video, several members of the Houston Texans. The emcee was his uncle, Michael Green. Because the OPC was closed for renovation, the event was held at the Scoular Ballroom. The Omaha native and NFL running back was a high school All-American at Omaha Central, helped lead the Nebraska Cornhuskers to two national titles and set team rushing and scoring records in seven seasons with the Green Bay Packers. The Omaha native was first drafted in the third round by the Seattle Seahawks in 1998 and played for them two seasons. In 2000, he was traded to the Green Bay Packers and played seven seasons there before signing with the Houston Texans in 2007. From 2000 through 2004, Green gained more yards from scrimmage and rushing yards than any other NFL player.
