

Mike and Stephanie Johanns to be honored Sept. 19 as next Face on Barroom Floor

Longtime newsmakers, U.S. Sen. Mike Johanns and Stephanie Johanns, will be the next “Face on the Barroom Floor” on Friday, Sept. 19. The fun begins with a 5:30 p.m. reception, dinner at 6:30 p.m., and the roast and the Face unveiling around 7:30 p.m.

Roasters scheduled to grill the Johanns are:

- Nebraska Press Association Executive Director Allen Beermann of Lincoln (Face No. 121 – May 2009);
- Sen. Deb Fischer – a Nebraska rancher, Fischer was elected to the U.S. Senate in 2012; and
- Jim and Lori McClurg of Lincoln. Jim McClurg is president of Technical Development Resources Company and a former member of the University of Nebraska Board of Regents. Lori McClurg is director of operations and associate director for student affairs at the Jeffrey S. Raikes School of Computer Science & Management at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.

In addition, Nebraska Gov. Dave Heineman will be on hand to introduce the Johanns before their Face is unveiled.

Mike Johanns has been a senator for Nebraska since 2009. He served on the Lincoln City Council from 1989 to 1991, became mayor of Lincoln in 1991 and was Nebraska’s governor from 1999 to 2005. From 2005 to 2008, he served as the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture.

Stephanie Johanns has served as a county commissioner for Lancaster County and as a Nebraska state senator. She is presently a senior vice president with Verizon in Washington, D.C.
